Storage of Dangerous and Toxic Substances Procedure

Rationale:

To provide a guideline on the storage of dangerous and toxic substances and checking of fluorescent lights.

Purpose:

- 1. To ensure all chemicals are locked safely away and kept out of reach of children.
- 2. To ensure chemicals are locked in their appropriate places, eg: cleaning chemicals in the cleaners cupboard.
- 3. To ensure all fluorescent lights are stored safely.

Guidelines:

- 1. All chemicals will be locked away and the key removed from the lock when not in use.
- 2. The chemicals are to be kept out of reach of the children at all times, especially when in use.
- 3. All chemicals are to be locked in their appropriate places so that they are not being carried around the school:
 - o Cleaning chemicals are to be locked in the Cleaners cupboard.
 - o Gardening chemicals are to be locked in the tool shed.
 - o Science chemicals are to be kept in a central storage area.
- 4. All chemicals will be stored in their original containers with suitable precaution taken not to destroy labels.
- 5. An inventory of dangerous chemicals will be maintained and held by the School Caretaker.
- 6. All fluorescent lights are to be checked regularly for damage of the phosphorous coating. If damaged, bulbs are to be removed and disposed of safely.
